Enhanced Confirmation Solution Interface: Additional Information

As previously announced, Eurex plans to introduce the new Enhanced Confirmation Solution interface within Eurex Release 13.0. The activation is planned shortly after the production launch of Eurex Release 13.0, which is scheduled to take place on November 8, 2010.

In order to provide interested Members with sufficient testing opportunities, the new interface will also be available in the Eurex Release 13.0 simulation, starting on September 6, 2010.

The Enhanced Confirmation Solution will allow Members to receive recoverable Order, Trade and Matching Event information without the necessity for a MISS Server thereby supporting Members in their migration to the exclusive use of socket-based interfaces for trading / front office API calls.

For this new service, Members will either require dedicated bandwidth of either 1 Mbit/s or 10 Mbit/s. Alternatively, Members will be able to share existing Enhanced Transaction Solution connectivity.

Fees for the dedicated 1 Mbit and 10 Mbit connections can be found in the updated version of the document "Price List to the Agreement on the technical connection and the utilization of the Electronic Trading System of Eurex Deutschland and Eurex Zürich (Connection Agreement)" which will be available under the following path from June 21, 2010 onwards:

The shared use of an existing Enhanced Transaction Solution connection will be provided at no further cost.

Similar to the Enhanced Transaction Solution, Members are also required to order broadcast sessions in order to connect to the Enhanced Confirmation Solution gateway infrastructure.

Please note that two broadcast sessions will be provided free of charge.

Explanation:

Depending on the chosen connection component and the number of connection components chosen, a monthly fee will be charged by Eurex Frankfurt AG.



The grand total of the monthly connection fees will be calculated by the sum of released connections of a Trading Member, multiplied by the amount of the relevant price per connection component.

In the event that a member establishes a VALUES API connection with the definition of the appropriate logical channels on a high bandwidth connection, any further additional 1 mbit/s leased-line connections which may be present will in general be charged at EUR 2,000.

2. Maturity

Connection fees according to section 1 will be charged monthly and become due by the third Business Day of the following calendar month.
