To support final preparations for the launch of the Eurex / KRX Link on August 30, 2010, Eurex and Korea Exchange (KRX) will provide additional system testing opportunities for the Eurex KOSPI Product on August 26, 27 and 28, 2010.

Access to the Eurex[®] production system to enter orders and quotes for the Eurex KOSPI Product will be available in order to provide:

1. KRX with the opportunity to test the dissemination of data for the Eurex KOSPI Product to KRX members through the KRX system;
2. KRX members with the opportunity to set up programs developed for the Eurex / KRX Link in production and test dissemination of data from the KRX system as well as order entry.

Eurex will offer access to the Eurex KOSPI Product in the Eurex production environment on Thursday, August 26 and Friday, August 27, 2010 from 07:45-08:45 CEST* (14:45-15:45 KST*). During this time, the Eurex KOSPI Product will be placed in the pre-opening phase to enable orders and quotes to be entered in the Eurex[®] production system.

Additionally, Eurex will open the Eurex[®] production system for a fixed time period on Saturday, August 28, 2010 from 10:00-14:00 CEST* (17:00-21:00 KST*) to enable testing opportunities for KRX members in the KRX production environment.

As testing is in the Eurex[®] production environment, orders and quotes entered into the Eurex[®] system will also be disseminated through Deutsche Börse AG's CEF[®] data feed. This data is therefore also available for vendors and customers of CEF[®].

Please note that only the Eurex production back-end will be started on Saturday, August 28, 2010 and will be up and running through the weekend without any support.
