Summary:

On August 25, 2010, the directors of Admiral Group PLC decided to pay an interims dividend of 32.60 pence. The company announced that 17.5 pence of the interims dividend shall be regarded as extraordinary dividend.

The extraordinary dividend will result in an adjustment of the Eurex stock futures contracts on shares of Admiral Group PLC (FLNF / FLNG).

Ex date will be **October 6, 2010**.

This circular contains a description of the adjustment procedure.

Adjustment of ISIN:

The ISIN of the Admiral Group PLC share (GB00B02J6398) will remain unchanged.

Procedure:**Determination of Adjustment Factor (R-Factor)**

The closing auction price of the Admiral Group PLC share at London Stock Exchange on the last cum trading day will be the basis for determination of the R-factor. First, this price will be reduced by the regular dividend. The price resulting from this serves for determination of the adjustment factor (R-factor).

S1	Closing auction price of the Admiral Group PLC share
S2	S1 minus regular dividend
S3	S2 minus extraordinary dividend
R-factor	S3/S2

1. Adjustment of Contract Size and Variation Margin

To adjust the calculation of the Variation Margin of the following exchange trading day, settlement prices of the last cum trading day will be multiplied by the R-factor.

The new contract size will be calculated as follows:

$$\text{Contract size new} = \text{contract size old} / \text{R-factor}$$

All outstanding orders and quotes will be deleted after close of trading on the last cum trading day.

The adjustment also refers to existing positions in OTC Flexible Futures.

2. Introduction of a new Contract

A new contract on Admiral Group PLC shares will be introduced with standard contract size 1000 and new product code FLNH.

The exact date of introduction will be published via the **Market Supervision Messages** window.

As soon as the new contract is available for trading and there are no more contract months with open interest in the original contracts on Admiral Group PLC shares (FLNF / FLNG), trading in these contracts will be put on "HALT" and finally discontinued.

Furthermore, effective October 6, 2010, no more contract months will be introduced in the original contracts (FLNF / FLNG). All existing series with no open interest will be suspended from trading.

If there is no open interest after close of trading on the last cum trading day in the original contracts on Admiral Group PLC (FLNF / FLNG) no adjustment will take place and no new contract will be introduced.
